PROHIBITED MATERIALS: If any of these above items are found in the Container <u>before it is picked up</u>, Valley Truck and its <u>employees may refuse to pick up the dumpster</u> until the items are removed by the renter. If any of these above items are found to be in the Valley Truck Dumpster Container <u>after it is picked up</u>, the renter of the container will be <u>liable for any extra cost</u> incurred by Valley Truck for disposal of such items. Be aware that the disposal of such items can be extremely expensive and can be hazardous to the health of those handling it and to the environment. Such items are strictly prohibited in the Container.

BY PRIOR ARRANGEMENT ONLY: Appliances are taken by prior arrangement only. Also: concrete, bricks, asphalt, clean soil, rock, sand, stone or any dense material can be taken only with prior arrangement. Please obtain permission first. DO NOT put these items into the dumpster along with other debris. They cannot go to the landfill and any fines or fees for separation of material will be charged to the renter's credit or debit card on file with this application.

DO NOT MIX LOADS: Mixing loads is strictly prohibited. DO NOT mix items such as and including garbage and shingles, electronics and concrete, concrete, or construction debris and dirt. If loads are mixed, the renter's card will be charged \$50 an hour for labor to separate the load.

CONTENTS OF ROLL-OFF CONTAINER: The contents of the dumpster Container are the responsibility of the renter. If someone dumps material into your Container with or without your knowledge, you are responsible for its contents and any and all charges related to the hauling and proper disposal.

DO NOT OVERFILL: Dumpster Containers can only be filled to the top of the rim. Employees may refuse to pick up the Container if it is overloaded. Material that spills over the top of the Container is potentially hazardous to our employees and vehicles on the roads. Some cities issue fines, and any fines incurred by Valley Truck will be charged to the renter's card.

FEES FOR EXCESS WEIGHT: Please observe the weight limits as specified in the payment agreement. All dumpster Containers are weighed at the disposal site. The renter's card will be charged any fees incurred by Container loads that exceed the weight limit in the payment agreement.

CAUTION WHEN LOADING: Dense materials, accepted only by prior arrangement as noted above, will fill the Container up to weight capacity before the interior space of the roll-off dumpster is full. For example, brick, concrete, clean soil, asphalt, rock, sand, and other heavy material can only be put into

the Container up to the X-way mark. We will not pick up a Container if our employees determine that it is overweight by any transportation-related laws and/or guidelines when they arrive at the renter's site. If Valley Truck receives any overweight violation while hauling your load, you will be charged the full amount of the violation and a surcharge fee on your account card on file.

VALLEY TRUCK IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR: Our drivers and employees are considerate and careful to make every effort to place your roll-off dumpster Container gently and on wooden blocks. However, Valley Truck is not responsible for any damage to driveways, lawns, sidewalks, curbs other road surfaces or underground utilities in the path to and away from the container. It is the responsibility of the renter, not Valley Truck, to obtain any required permits or walvers issued by state, county or local ordinances.

DAMAGE TO ROLL-OFF DUMPSTER CONTAINER: The renter is responsible for any damaged caused to the Container while it is in your possession. The renter also is not allowed to make any alterations or improvements to any Container.

ACCESS TO CONTAINER: Valley Truck will always schedule a time for placement and pick-up with the renter. However, the renter must keep Container accessible to the Valley Truck dumpster truck during the day of the scheduled time, including removing all vehicles, yard furniture and debris in the way.
